Headline Facts and Figures

Attainment:

These are the first key stage 2 attainment statistics since 2019, after assessments were cancelled in 2020 and 2021 due to the pandemic.

These statistics cover the attainment of year 6 pupils who took assessments in summer 2022. These pupils experienced disruption to their learning during the pandemic, particularly at the end of year 4 and in year 5.

For Great Barton 67% of pupils met the expected standard in all of reading, writing and maths, compared to 59% of children nationally and 53.5% in Suffolk LA.

In individual subjects, the national picture was that attainment increased slightly in reading and fell in all other subjects.

For Great Barton, 81% of children met the expected standard in reading compared with 74% nationally.

For Great Barton, 85% of children met the expected standard in maths compared with 71% nationally.

For Great Barton, 74% of children met the expected standard in writing compared with 69% nationally.

For Great Barton, 81% of children met the expected standard in grammar, punctuation and spelling compared with 72% nationally. For

Great Barton, 85% of children met the expected standard in science compared with 79% nationally.

The national average scaled score for spelling, punctuation and grammar is 105. Great Barton's average scaled score is 108

The national average scaled score for maths is 104. Great Barton's average scaled score is 106

Progress:

All pupil premium and SEND children made at least expected progress based on their KS1 teacher assessment scores.

81% of all children made at least expected progress in **reading, writing and maths** (not just one area) based on their KS1 teacher assessment scores, including 100% of pupil premium and SEND children.

30% of children went from expected at key stage 1 to greater depth at key stage 2 in their reading.

22% of children went from pre-key stage to working towards or from working towards to expected in maths.

30% of children went from pre-key stage to working towards or from working towards to expected in writing.

Our progress scores were all positive and have improved since the 2019 assessments:

Up from 0.71 (2019) to 3.6 (2022)

Up from -2.76 (2019) to 2.2 (2022)

Up from 1.20 (2019) to 3.7 (2022)
