**Cecily:** she helps her buddy, other people and she is in the Eco Team (and she is good at it) so she is helping the environment and she helps me when I am sad (main reason why).

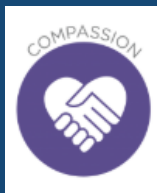
