

## Y4 – MONEY

These are the coins we use in the UK. We can make any amount using these coins, e.g. 38p = 20p + 10p + 5p + 2p + 1p



There are different combinations, e.g. 5p + 5p + 5p + 5p + 5p + 5p + 5p + 2p + 1p

There are 100 pence in 1 pound (100p = £1)

To convert pounds to pence we x by 100

$$£1.45 = 145p$$

To convert pence to pounds ÷ by 100

$$173p = £1.73$$

We use either £ or p not both at the same time

A decimal point separates pounds and pence

We can round amounts of money to the nearest whole pound.
